This publication provides the Cabinet proposal and report back on Hon Judith Collins KC's travel over the period 16 – 23 October 2025 to the United States of America in order to meet with counterparts under her Defence and GCSB/NZSIS portfolios.

Proposed Overseas Travel: Hon Judith Collins KC - October 2025

Portfolios Defence / GCSB / NZSIS / Space

On 6 October 2025, Cabinet:

1 **authorised** the absence of Hon Judith Collins KC from New Zealand, subject to leave from
Parliament being secured, from s6(a) October 2025, to travel to:

1.1 Washington DC, USA for bilateral meetings;

2 **agreed** that she be accompanied by two members of staff, one of whose costs will be met by
Vote Defence;

3 **approved** the estimated expenditure of up to s6(a) for the travel expenses of the
ministerial party as a charge to Vote Internal Affairs (Members of the Executive – Travel);

4 **noted** that she will also be accompanied by a delegation from the Ministry of Defence and
the New Zealand Defence Force, whose costs will be met by their agencies;

5 **agreed** that in her absence:

5.1 Hon Paul Goldsmith act as Attorney-General, Minister Responsible for the GCSB
and Minister Responsible for the NZSIS;

5.2 Hon Chris Penk act as Minister of Defence;

5.3 Hon James Meager act as Minister for Digitising Government, Minister for the
Public Service and Minister for Space;

Proposed Overseas Travel: Hon Judith Collins KC – October 2025

- 1 I seek Cabinet approval to travel to the USA [REDACTED] s6(a) October under my Defence and GCSB/NZSIS portfolios.

- 3 In Washington DC I will seek calls with key Defence, Space, and Intelligence counterparts. This will provide a valuable opportunity to strengthen bilateral ties and deepen mutual understanding.

I recommend that Cabinet note this report on my travel to Washington DC, United States of America from 16 October to 23 October to meet with Defence and Intelligence counterparts.


Report

- 1 My visit to Washington provided an opportunity to meet with Secretary of War, Pete Hegseth and a wide range of US cabinet secretaries and senior officials, mostly in relation to my Space and National Security portfolios. A full list of who I met with is as follows:
 - 1.1 Secretary of War, Pete Hegseth (accompanied by Undersecretary of War for Policy, Elbridge Colby and Chairman of the Joint Chiefs, General Dan Caine)
 - 1.2 Secretary of Homeland Security, Kristi Noem
 - 1.3 US Attorney General, Pam Bondi
 - 1.4 Director of the CIA, John Ratcliffe
 - 1.5 Acting Director of the NSA, Lieutenant General, William J. Hartman
 - 1.6 Deputy Assistant to the President and Senior Director for Counterterrorism, Dr Sebastian Gorka
 - 1.7 Principal Deputy Director in the Office of the Director of National Intelligence, T.H. Aaron Lukas
 - 1.8 Senior NASA and Commerce officials in the Space portfolio
- 2 I also placed a wreath at Arlington National Cemetery and visited the Rocket Lab's Neutron rocket production facility in Maryland.
- 3 In my meetings with Defence and Intelligence counterparts, I emphasised that New Zealand is a reliable security partner, and underscored the deep appreciation New Zealand has for the US' role in upholding global security. Secretary Hegseth and Undersecretary Elbridge Colby acknowledged New


Zealand's commitment to doubling its defence expenditure under the Defence Capability Plan 2025. s6(a)


